

# Potholder

You will need about 60 g of yarn.














This potholder consists of two identical parts that are joined with sc.  
 Each round ends with a slip stitch.  
 Start each new round somewhere else.  
 Weave in ends after each round,  
 or they will get in the way.











## Abbreviations:

Sc: single crochet    dc: double crochet    ch: chain    st/s: stitch/es

		Sc in loop, ch 2 = 1. dc
14 dc = 15 dc	2 dc in each stitch.	
*2 dc in 1 <sup>st</sup> st, 1 dc in next st*.		*2 dc, ch1, 2 dc in 1 <sup>st</sup> stitch, skip 2 sts*

		
	In space: 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc	
		
In space: 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc		In space: 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1
		
	In space: 4 dc, ch 3, 4 dc, ch 2	
		
In space: 5 dc, ch 4, 5 dc, ch 3	In space: 10 dc Ch 1, sc in 3-ch-loop of previous round, ch 1	Make two of them.
<b>Joining the parts</b>		
	Put both parts together on wrong side. Sc in 1-ch of previous round. Ch 20.	

		
<p>Rotate by 180 ° ☺. Sc in space between dark and light yellow. You will now join the parts with sc.</p>	<p>The thread is underneath your work. Make sure the sc are rather loose. Sc all the way to the third round.</p>	<p>Sc in 1<sup>st</sup> st of 3<sup>rd</sup> round. Rotate by 180 ° ☺. Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st of 3<sup>rd</sup> round.</p>
		
<p>Sc up into same loops as on your way to the center.</p>	<p>Sc in space between dark and light yellow.</p>	<p>Sc in each dc of previous round.</p>
		
<p>Sc in space between dark and light yellow.</p>	<p>Rotate and sc to the center.</p>
