

## Panama Hat for Little Girls

For the hat (without the flowers and leaves) you will need about 50-60 g of yarn.



Abbreviations:







ch: chain





sc: single crochet

dc: double crochet



sl st: slip stitch






fpdc: front post double crochet

	Start with a magic ring. Ch 3 (=1 <sup>st</sup> dc), then 15 dc. Close with sl st.		Makes 16 dc.
2			
	Ch 3 (=1 <sup>st</sup> dc). Ch 1. In each dc of previous row: front post double crochet (fpdc).		End with sl st. Makes 16 fpdc.
3			

	Ch 3 (=1 <sup>st</sup> dc), ch1. Fpdc in dc right below ch-3. Ch 1, dc in fpdc of prev. row.	
		
	Fpdc in same fpdc of prev. row. Finish with sl st. Makes 16 dc, 16 fpdc and 16 ch.	
4		
	Ch 3 (=1 <sup>st</sup> dc). * Ch 1, fpdc in next fpdc of prev. row. Ch 1, dc in dc of prev. row*.	Finish with sl st. Makes 16 dc, 16 fpdc and 32 ch.
5		
	Ch 3 (=1 <sup>st</sup> dc). Dc in 3 <sup>rd</sup> ch of prev. row. *Ch 1, fpdc in fpdc of prev. row, ch 1, 2 dc in dc of prev. row.* Makes 16 fpdc, 32 dc and 32 ch.

	<p>Ch 3 Ch 3 (=1<sup>st</sup> dc). Dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of prev. row. Dc in next dc.</p> <p>*Ch 1, fpdc in fpdc of prev. row, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc.*</p> <p>Makes 16 fpdc, 48 dc, 32 ch.</p>
7.	
	<p>Ch 3 Ch 3 (=1<sup>st</sup> dc). Dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of prev. row. Dc in next dc, dc in next dc.</p> <p>*Ch 1, fpdc in fpdc of prev. row, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc.*</p> <p>Makes 16 fpdc, 64 dc, 32 ch.</p> <p>Now we're done increasing.</p>

	<p>Ch 3 Ch 3 (=1<sup>st</sup> dc). Dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of prev. row. Dc in next dc, dc in next dc. Skip the last dc. (Skipping the last dc will create a spiral effect). *Ch 1, fpdc in fpdc of prev. row, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc.* Makes 16 fpdc, 54 dc, 32 ch.</p>		
	Repeat the 8 <sup>th</sup> row 10 times.		
<b>Brim</b>			
1		2	
	Sc in each st of prev. row: 16 x 7 st.		Increase: 2 sc in 1 <sup>st</sup> sc of prev. row, 6 sc.
3		4	
	Add two rows of sc.		Increase: 2 sc in 1 <sup>st</sup> sc of prev. row, 7 sc.

5	Add three rows of sc.	6	
			Done.
<p>If you want the brim to be wider, make another increase: 2 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of prev. row, 8 sc. Then add more rows.</p>
