
Leather Pouch

Supplies:

- Bits of leather
- Punch
- Cutting mat
- Cutter
- Ruler
- Waxed cord
- Beading yarn
- Glass beads
- Metal beads
- Sewing needle
- Wool needle
- Pendant
- Claps of sort

The leather part measures 3,1" x 2,4" (8 x 6 cm).

| | Mark the line, where the beaded threads will be attached. Make the holes, first with the sewing needle then with the wool needle. I placed the holes 0.12" (3mm) apart. | | Thread the beads and pull the yarn through the hole. Tie a double knot. Maybe dab a little nail polish on it. |

| | Done. | | Cut a piece long enough to sew both sides together and for the necklace part. I added glass beads and separated them with knots. |

| | Tie a double knot at the end of the waxed cord. Dab a little glue on the other end to harden the tip. Start at the bottom of the pouch and join the parts on one side. | | Make the necklace part. |

| | Then join the parts on the other side. | | Mark the site for the claps and punch out |

| | Finish with a double knot. | two small holes. | |

| | Attach the clasp and the pendant. I simply tied a knot each on the inside. Also round the flap if you like. | | |

| | Punch little holes along the edge of the flap and sew on beads. I finished off the ends by adding glass beads. | | |
