

## How to Wrap a Tooth Shaped Stone





Supplies:

- Beading thread
- Crochet needle
- Waxed cord



This tutorial is only a guide line.

Depending on the size of your stone, you might have to chain more or fewer stitches.  
Make sure the stitches are divisible by five.

	Find a tooth shaped stone.
	Make a chain of 20 and close with a slip stitch.
	Check, if it fits.
	Chain 11, skip 3 stitches and make a single crochet. Repeat 5 times. Finish round with a slip stitch.



Make slip stitches to the 5<sup>th</sup> chain stitch.  
Chain 11, single crochet in center of next loop.  
\* Chain 11, single crochet in center of next loop.\*  
Repeat from \*to\* four times.  
Finish with a slip stitch.

Repeat this round until you almost reach the top of the stone.



Make slip stitches to the 5<sup>th</sup> chain stitch.  
Finish off and connect the five loop centers.

Weave in ends.
