How to Wrap a Tooth Shaped Stone

Supplies:

- Beading thread
- Crochet needle
- Waxed cord



This tutorial is only a guide line.

Depending on the size of your stone, you might have to chain more or fewer stitches.

Make sure the stitches are divisible by five.

Find a tooth shaped stone.
Make a chain of 20 and close with a slip stitch.
Check, if it fits.
Chain 11, skip 3 stitches and make a single crochet. Repeat 5 times. Finish round with a slip stitch.



Make slip stitches to the 5th chain stitch. Chain 11, single crochet in center of next loop. * Chain 11, single crochet in center of next loop.*

Repeat from *to* four times. Finish with a slip stitch.

Repeat this round until you almost reach the top of the stone.



Make slip stitches to the 5th chain stitch.

Finish off and connect the five loop centers.

Weave in ends.
