

Sailor's Knot Bracelet (Josephine Knot)

Supplies:

- Cord (hemp, leather, silk...)
- Coil ends
- Split ring
- Lobster clasp



<p>This round is for practice. Take two strands of (here) yellow cord and follow the instructions on the drawing. Take both strand of (here) pink cord and follow the yellow cord.</p>	
<p>Now for the real thing: Cut four strands of leather cord. Each strand is half the circumference of your bracelet.</p>	<p>Take two strands and tie the first part. With the other two follow the first ones. Align the ends, cut to the same length if necessary. Check, if the bracelet fits your wrist.</p>
	<p>Dab a little glue on your cord ends or into the spring coil end. Insert the cord ends all the way into your end caps. With fine pliers squeeze in the last coil until it's pinching the actual cord.
