

Granny Square Pillow

Supplies:







- Yarn
- Stuffed pillow






Abbreviations:







- sl st: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- dc: double crochet
- ch: chain
- 2dctog: 2 double crochet together





This pillow measures 13.8". Each round finishes with a sl st. Start each round at a different corner.

	<p>Magic ring, sc in ring.</p>		<p>ch 3 (= 1st dc), 2 dc, ch2 *3dc, ch2*. Repeat from * to * three times. Finish off.</p>

	<p>Tie both ends together on wrong side and leave be.</p>		<p>Pick next color. Wrap yarn around crochet needle twice, pull yarn through corner space and make a dc.</p>

	<p>Like so. = 2nd dc</p>		<p>1 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same corner space, ch1 *in next corner space: 3 dc, ch2, 3 dc,</p>

			ch1*. Repeat from * to * three times.
7		8	
	Dc in 1 st corner space, sl st. Finish off.		Tie both ends together on wrong side.

	Weave in ends of first round like so. First to the right then back to the left.

	2dc, ch2, 3 dc in same corner space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1. *In next corner space: 3 dc, ch2, 3 dc, ch 1. Then ch 1, 3 dc in next space, ch 1*. Repeat from * to * three times. 1 dc in 1 st corner space, sl st. Finish off.

	Weave in ends of second round.

<p>2dc, ch2, 3 dc in same corner space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1. *In next corner space: 3 dc, ch2, 3 dc, ch1. Then ch 1, 3 dc in next space, ch 1*. Repeat from * to * three times. 1 dc in 1st corner space. Finish off. Weave in ends of 3rd round.</p>		<p>Last round: 2dc, ch2, 3 dc in same corner space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1. 3 dc in next space, ch 1. Stop. Weave in ends of 4th round.</p>	
Connecting the squares

<p>Unhook crochet needle from work and insert in corner space of a finished square. Get loop (yellow) and pull through. Sc, 3 dc in same corner space, ch 1.</p>			
15			
<p>Continue connection the square until you get to the last corner. dc in first corner space, sl st. Finish off, tie both end together and weave them in.</p>

	Back Side
	You can sew the cover onto the pillow or crochet a net like so.
	
	<p>Start at any space except the corners.</p> <p>1st round: Dc in space, ch 3. Finish rd with sl st.</p> <p>2nd round: sl st in 1st ch st, sc, ch 5. *dc in next space, ch 3*. Repeat from * to * until you get to a corner. Then: 2 dctog. Continue with ch 3 dc to next corner. Finish rd with sl st.</p> <p>3rd -9th round: repeat round two.</p> <p>Last round: 3 sc in space, 1 sc in dc of prev. round. Finish with sl st. Finish off and weave in ends.</p>
	The corners look like this.
	

Block your work if necessary.

If you feel like you want more rows in the back keep adding. Make sure your pillow fits through the hole.
