

Bag Dispenser

Supplies:

- Yarn
- Crochet needle

Abbreviations:

- ch: chain
- sl st: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- dc: double crochet
- st/sts: stitch/stitches

You can make this bag as long or as wide as you need it to be. One group of dc's consists of 4 sts (3 dc, 1 ch).

I used the same color for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd row.

Then I picked a different color for every row.

1		<p>Make a chain of 36 sts and close the ring with a sl st.</p>
2		<p>Sc in every st = 36 sts.</p>
3		<p>*Dc, ch 1*. Repeat from *to* 36 times. = 72 sts</p>

4		<p>Change color.</p> <p>*3 dc in dc of previous round, ch1. Skip 1ch, 1 dc, 1ch.*</p> <p>Repeat from *to* 18 times.</p>
5		<p>Keep adding rows up to the desired length.</p>
6		<p>Add a picot round for embellishment.</p> <p>Picot: *sc in gap, ch 3, sc in 1st ch st*.</p> <p>Repeat from *to* 18 times.</p>
7		<p>Depending on how and where you want to hang your bag, you might need a loop or a string with one end or two or a combination of it.</p> <p>I wanted my bag to have a loop and a drawstring.</p> <p>Ch 50, sc in 1st dc of 2nd to last round, ch 22, sc in 3rd dc of 2nd to last round, ch 50.</p> <p>Weave chain through last round, fill bag. Done!</p>
