





Scrunchie



Feel free to crochet as many scrunchies as you like. You might even want to sell them. But please don't make copies and/or distribute this tutorial. Thank you.

<p>Crochet language:</p> <p>ch: chain sl st: slip stitch sc: single crochet dc: double crochet</p>		<p>How to crochet a picot :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Chain (ch) 3. 2. Insert your hook in the third chain from the hook. 3. Yarn over (yo) and draw the yarn through the stitch. 4. Yarn over and draw the yarn through both loops on the hook.

<p>Okay, let's start. What you need is: some cotton thread, 1.8 mm crochet hook (or any size that works well with your thread/yarn) and a good quality pony tail band.</p>		<p>*sc into band, chain 3*. Repeat from* to* all around the hair band. You may need to slide the stitches down to cover the band. Join with sl st into first chain-3 space.</p>

You've finishes round 1.		Sl st to center of space. Ch 3 (=1 st dc). Ch 2, dc into same space. *Ch 2, dc into next space, ch2, dc into same space*. Repeat from * to * all around, join with sl st into 3 rd st of 1 st dc.

You've finishes round 1.		Sl st to center of chain-2 space. Sc into same space, picot. *Sc into next space, picot*. Repeat from * to * all around, join with sl st into 1 st sc.
